The Queen's House

Discover 500 years of Britain's encounter with the world at sea at the world's largest Maritime Museum.

Our guided tour will cover many topics including Scott and Shackleton's polar expeditions (including Percy the Penguin!), Captain Cook's pacific exploration, and famous sea battles, including Drake, the Spanish Armada and Nelson's campaigns.

You will also be able to visit the Queen's House which is close to the Museum. A bright white villa completed in 1630 which was a luxurious retreat for Stuart Kings and Queens. The House captures that early spirit of art and creativity. Historic paintings and interiors blending with contemporary art and sculpture.

The Museum has two cafés: either the Parkside with plenty of seating both indoors and outdoors or the Ocean Court for drinks and snacks. Alternatively bring a picnic and sit in the glorious green grounds which surround the Museum and the Queen's House. Six individual lawns offer views over the Thames to the London skyline and Greenwich Park.
